† Call to Worship

Psalm 24

The worship service begins with a Scriptural “call to worship.” It is God Himself who calls His people to worship. We do not call ourselves, but it is the King who opens His gates and beckons us into His courts. Worship is a reflexive and deliberate response to His gracious call.

† Hymn of Approach

The Hymn or Chorus of Approach serves to draw our hearts and minds to the living God. Usually a joyous shout to the Lord acknowledging the reality of awe and wonder in the presence of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Confession of Faith

Westminster Larger Catechism Q&A 9-11

Jesus says, “Everyone therefore who shall confess Me before men; I will also confess him before My Father who is in Heaven.” We have been given “the faith once for all passed down to the saints” and we thank God for the preservation of His Word.

Q. 9. How many persons are there in the Godhead?

A. **There be three persons in the Godhead, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost; and these three are one true, eternal God, the same in substance, equal in power and glory; although distinguished by their personal properties.**

Q. 10. What are the personal properties of the three persons in the Godhead?

A. **It is proper to the Father to beget the Son, and to the Son to be begotten of the Father, and to the Holy Ghost to proceed from the Father and the Son from all eternity.**

Q. 11. How doth it appear that the Son and the Holy Ghost are God equal with the Father?

A. **The Scriptures manifest that the Son and the Holy Ghost are God equal with the Father, ascribing unto them such names, attributes, works, and worship, as are proper to God only.**
