† Call to Worship

Psalm 92:1-4

The worship service begins with a Scriptural “call to worship.” It is God Himself who calls His people to worship. We do not call ourselves, but it is the King who opens His gates and beckons us into His courts. Worship is a reflexive and deliberate response to His gracious call.

† Invocation

This prayer exalts the Name of the Lord and invokes His presence and communion as we come to worship Him.

† Hymn of Approach

Guide Me, O Thou Great Jehovah - 598

The Hymn or Chorus of Approach serves to draw our hearts and minds to the living God. Usually a joyous shout to the Lord acknowledging the reality of awe and wonder in the presence of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

Confession of Faith

Westminster Shorter Catechism 53-56

Jesus says, “Everyone therefore who shall confess Me before men; I will also confess him before My father who is in Heaven.” We have been given “the faith once for all passed down to the saints” and we thank God for the preservation of His Word.

Q. 53. Which is the third commandment?

A. **The third commandment is, *Thou shalt not take the name of the Lord thy God in vain: for the Lord will not hold him guiltless that taketh his name in vain.***

Q. 54. What is required in the third commandment?

A. **The third commandment requireth the holy and reverent use of God’s names, titles, attributes, ordinances, Word, and works.**

Q. 55. What is forbidden in the third commandment?

A. **The third commandment forbiddeth all profaning or abusing of anything whereby God maketh Himself known.**

Q. 56. What is the reason annexed to the third commandment?

A. **The reason annexed to the third commandment is, that however the breakers of this commandment may escape punishment from men, yet the Lord our God will not suffer them to escape His righteous judgment.**

The Hymn or Chorus of Praise focuses on giving praise to our God. It focuses on who He is, what He has done, and reminds us that it is good and proper to give Him praise because He is worthy.
