† Call to Worship

Confession of Faith

Westminster Shorter Catechism 91-93

Jesus says, “Everyone therefore who shall confess Me before men; I will also confess him before My Father who is in Heaven.” We have been given “the faith once for all passed down to the saints” and we thank God for the preservation of His Word.

Q. 91. How do the sacraments become effectual means of salvation?

A. **The sacraments become effectual means of salvation, not from any virtue in them, or in him that doth administer them; but only by the blessing of Christ, and the working of His Spirit in them that by faith receive them.**

Q. 92. What is a sacrament?

A. **A sacrament is an holy ordinance instituted by Christ; wherein, by sensible signs, Christ, and the benefits of the new covenant, are represented, sealed, and applied to believers.**

Q. 93. Which are the sacraments of the New Testament?

A. **The sacraments of the New Testament are, baptism, and the Lord’s supper.**
